Discussion Questions:

- 3. In v. 4, what does Paul mean that we "do not provoke your children to anger"?
- 4. In v. 4, what does Paul mean that we "bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord"?

Application Questions:

- 1. As a family, do you have an objective that you parent towards? Is there one main thing you are focusing your parenting energy towards? If not, what might it look like to create that?
- 2. Whether we find ourselves with or without kids in the home, how might we be invested in the church family in the raising of our kids collectively?
